LOW-INTEREST LOANS AVAILABLE THROUGH WHEELS FOR WORK:

- Repair loans up to \$1,000
- Down-payment loans up to \$1,500
- 0% interest on the life of the loan
- A 5% administrative fee will be taken out of the first two payments.

LOAN EXAMPLES:

Loan Amount	# of Months	Admin. Fee	Monthly Payment	Amount Repaid
\$500	18	5%	\$30	\$525
\$1,000	24	5%	\$45	\$1,050
\$1,500	33	5%	\$50	\$1,575

INTERESTED APPLICANTS MUST:

- Be continuously employed for three months.
- Possess a valid Wisconsin driver's license.
- Have or be able to obtain auto liability insurance per Wisconsin legal minimums.
- Own the vehicle in need of repairs.
- Fall within income guidelines (\$44,100 for a family of four).
- Be a resident of Buffalo, Eau Claire, Jackson or Trempealeau County.
- Agree to participate in a rideshare program for six months www.rideshareetc.org
- Have no outstanding fines or have verifiable payment agreements for those fines.
